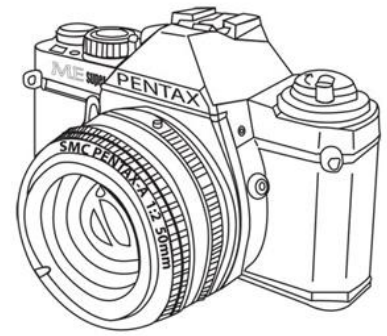

Club to honour four eminent photographers: Styant Browne, Smithies, Perrin and Pattison

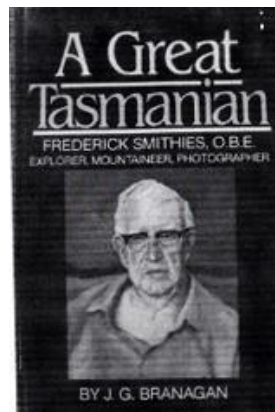
Four great photographers of the Northern Tasmanian Camera Club will be honoured by having club awards named after them.



Frank Styant Browne

- Driving force to form the club, first Secretary, Treasurer and Librarian, Secretary of the Club for 20 years
- The Aggregate Trophy for colour images will be named after him

Frederick Smithies OBE

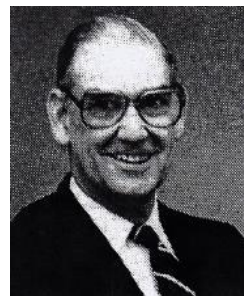


- One of the giants of wilderness photography in Tasmania
- Awarded the Order of the British Empire in 1946
- The Colour Photo of the Year will be named after him



Florence Perrin

- Wife of eminent club member, George Perrin
- As a woman, barred from being a member of NTCC
- Led many expeditions to wilderness areas
- Florence's photographs were taken on her own independently organised expeditions
- The Aggregate Trophy for monochrome images will be named after her



Geoffrey Pattison OAM

- President of NTCC from 1972 to 1974, 1976 to 1981, 1982 to 1989
- Winner of Robert Mackrill Trophy in 1976, 1977 and 1981, and Slide of the Year 1978.
- Awarded the Order of Australia Medal in 1998
- The Monochrome Photo of the Year will be named after him.
