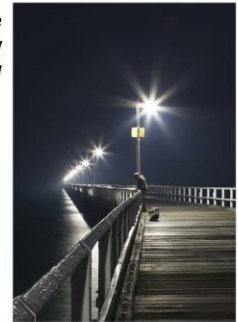

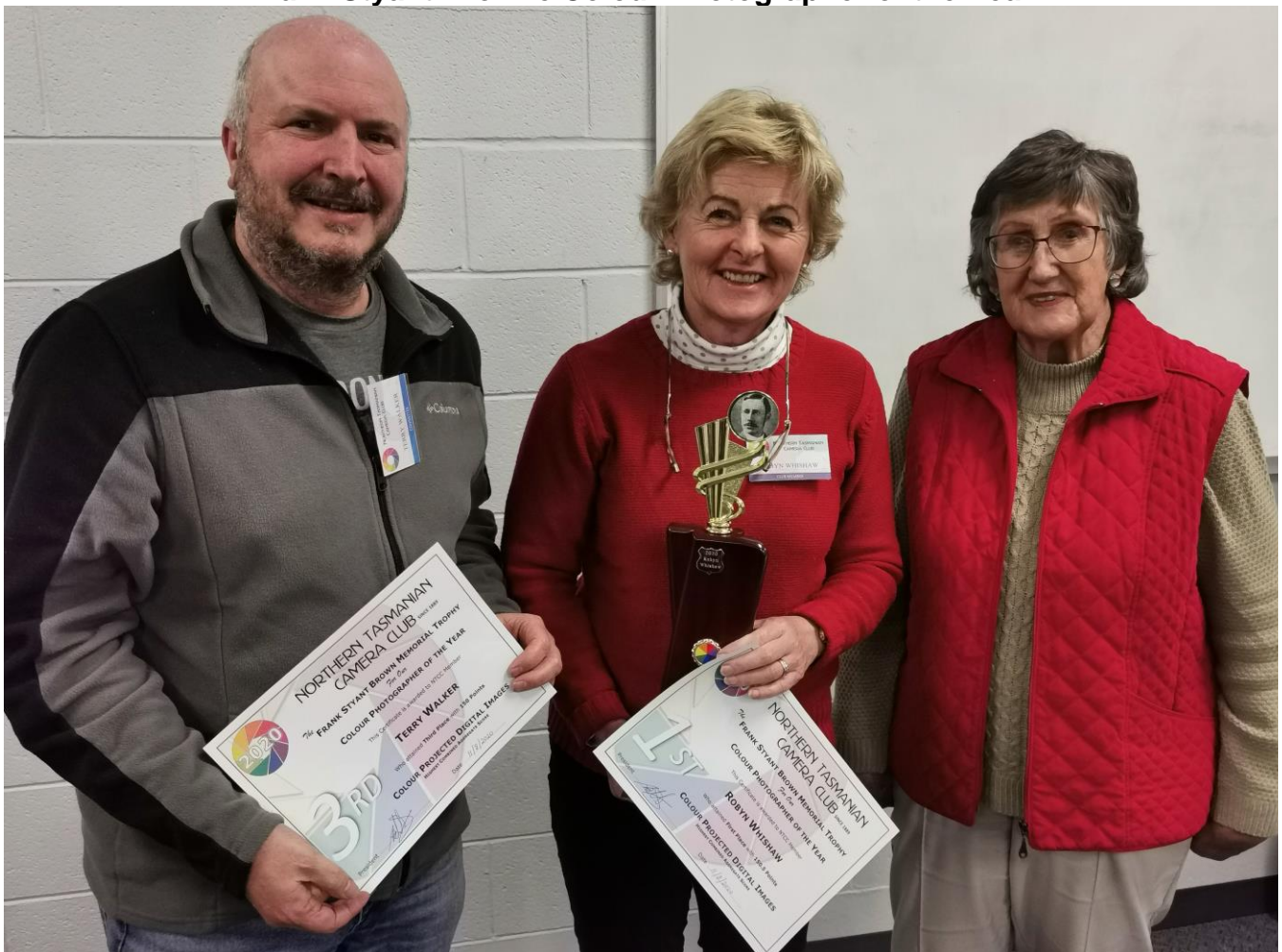

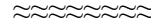
### Fund raising
