### **A guide to photography books.**

Many photography books are available on bookselling websites such as Amazon, Angus and Robertson, Book Depository, Booktopia, ebay, QBD Books and World of Books. Prices vary and some books are available second-hand at low cost. However, some second-hand books on the market are very old and do not cover digital photography. Many of the classic books on photography from the pre-digital era are largely or completely about black and white photography.

Some 'eBooks' are available as pdf downloads while others can only be read on-line or require book-readers such as Kindle. Be careful of sites offering 'free' eBooks or pdfs. Some are malware sites. Libraries Tasmania also has an extensive collection of photography books.
